



SHAPE MT TEACHER OF THE YEAR (TOY) AWARD

SHAPE MT awards Teacher of the Year Awards to 3 levels of teaching: Elementary, Middle School, and High School. The nominee must have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience to be eligible for nomination. The nominee must be a current member of SHAPE Montana.

If selected for Montana TOY, the winner will be eligible to compete for the Western District TOY. The Western District includes the states of: Washington, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Alaska, Arizona, New Mexico, California, Hawaii, Utah and Nevada. If a candidate were to be chosen Western District TOY, they would then be eligible to compete for National Teacher of the Year.

Page 2 of the application is the nomination form for each level. The SHAPE Montana Awards Chair will contact the nominees. Please provide all information for this purpose.

The nominee will be required to complete the following for the state level:

- Application Form
- Teaching Philosophy Statement
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Publicity Form
- Lesson Plan
