All schools and universities are eligible, including county and city government agencies, housing developments and private for-profit organizations.</p>



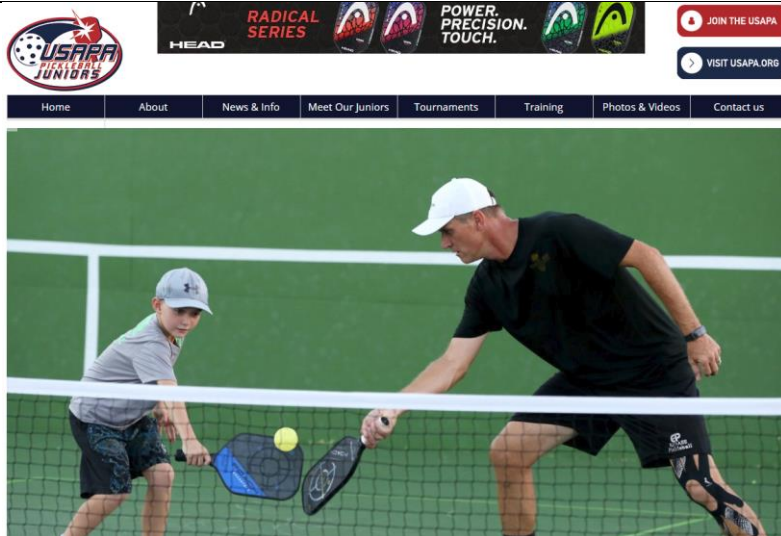
### USAPA Ambassadors
